# Fundraising event – new total

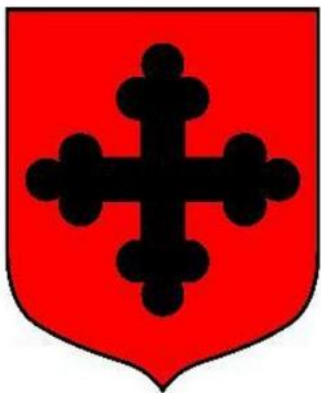
We are excited to announce that our Young Carers and Service Children have organised a fun run event happening in school on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.
