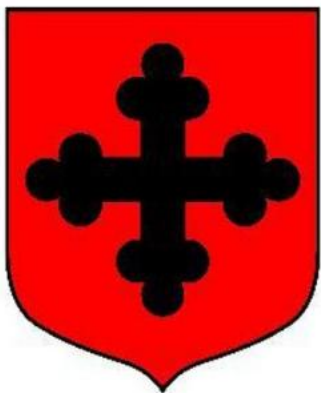




# Lost Property
