Our school


Our school comprises of 12 classrooms and a number of other working spaces – including shared spaces at both north and south end. Our school hall is used for daily worship, school lunch, PE and performances. We have a well-stocked library and each year group has access to laptops and iPads to support learning. Outside areas include a 22 element play trail, two table tennis tables, four 4 square courts and 10 basketball hoops. Our playground recently makeover and now has six new games and fourteen exercise stations.

<u>PE</u>

All year groups have PE lessons at least once a week. Your child will need the following items of clothing for their PE kit:

- sports trainers
- plain t-shirt (in their house colour which will be confirmed later)
- black sports shorts
- black football socks
- plain black sweatshirt (no hoodies) OR logo quarter zip sweatshirt available from PL School Wear

PE takes place indoors and outdoors; therefore, additional layers may be worn outside in cold weather. Tight fitting shorts or leggings may be worn underneath their PE shorts, but not as a replacement. Children may keep their PE kits in school.

ParentPay

Once we have received your completed admission forms we will send home a ParentPay activation letter which will enable you to order hot lunches online via ParentPay. ParentPay is also used to pay for school trips and events. Until you receive your activation details you will need to provide a packed lunch for your child. Please be mindful that we are a **NO NUT** school when providing a packed lunch.

If you would like your child to have a hot lunch in school these can be booked up to 8am each day, if the cut off time is missed a packed lunch will need to be provided on that day. If your child is ill or absent from school you must cancel meals through ParentPay, or you will still be charged.
