- Understand the indefinite determiner (a) and the possessive adjectives (my)
- Understand the positive / negative for what I have/do not have in my pencil case



Know & Do

- Learn the nouns and determiners for 12 classroom objects
- Learn to ask and answer the question '¿Qué tienes en tu estuche?' (What do have in your pencil case?)
- Learn to say what I do not have in my pencil case. (En mi estuche, no tengo.....)
- Independently produce sentences about what is in my imaginary pencil case incorporating colours and numbers
- Pronounce and record words with some accuracy
