Create, Communicate & Evaluate

- Describe a miracle and explain the positive impact on believers



Question, Reason, Discuss & Explain

- Suggest reasons why people believe or disbelieve
- Assess the impact of miracles on disciples, people of the time and modern-day believers
- Assess whether the stories have to be true to positively impact the lives of believers (refer to Y3 summer)



Know & Do

- Know a number of stories that describe the miracles of Jesus; ask questions about their meaning
- Identify links between the stories of Jesus' miracles and the work of the church today

Opportunities to support English and maths
