In this unit, we will learn how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved & reused. We will consider the impact that editing images can have & evaluate the effectiveness of our choices.

Create a book cover or poster using edited images and text	
 Question, Reason, Discuss & Explain	
Explain how the composition of digital images can be changed & why people change them	
Explain how colours can be changed in digital images and how that may affect the viewer	
Explain that images can be combined and explain why they may be edited this way	
Discuss why we need to consider whether an image online has been retouched and edited	
Explain why some countries have laws to tell you if an image has been edited

Use photo editing software to edit, crop and rotate an image	
Add and remove parts of a composition using cloning	
Combine text and images in a project	
Review images and use feedback to make changes to a project	
Know that media, advertisers and online content can be altered and edited to appear real
