Question, Reason, Discuss & Explain

1. Use a wider range of historical terms and phrases relating to the era and to historical study
2. Understand that sources have a purpose and audience; analyse propaganda posters and create a piece of propaganda
3. Use a range of sources to identify the main causes of WWI; understand that some sources of information are more useful than others and that there are different opinions about the past
4. Explore different viewpoints about going to war (political, personal, religious, moral...)
5. Find reasons to explain why different countries joined together (triple alliance / entente or triple axis)
6. Use a range of sources to research life at the front line; explain why WWI was so significant and how it has affected the modern world
7. Research how WWI impacted the local area and families

8. Site the period on a timeline and describe the location of other periods (KS1 topics, Stone Age, Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece, Roman Britain, Mayans, Anglo-Saxons, The Victorians)
9. Order the main events leading up to and during WW1 on a time line.
