14. A mixture of simple , compound and complex sentences used effectively.			
15. Ambitious vocabulary, including topic words, used accurately.			
16. Past and present tense used correctly and consistently.			
17. Correct spelling of high frequency words, including the Y3 statutory words.			
18. Use of a dictionary to check your spelling.			
19. Evidence of evaluation and redrafting that has led to improvement.
